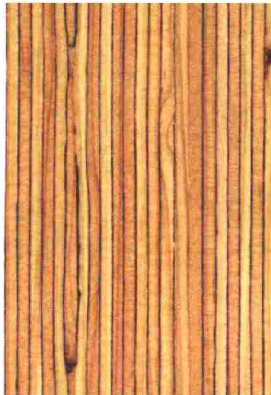

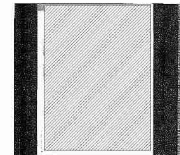
▶ ECOLINEA WOOD PANELS
